## COUNCIL CHAPLAIN

My Brother Knights,

“The Resurrection of Jesus is the crowning truth of our faith in Christ”(CCC 638). This month, as a Church, we will celebrate the Resurrection with great joy. But as we prepare to do so, it is important to remember that the Paschal mystery includes not only the Resurrection of Jesus, but also his passion, and death as well. In order to fully experience the joy of the Resurrection, we need to fully enter into the Paschal mystery. One way of doing this is to participate in the services offered in our parishes during the Sacred Triduum - Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Holy Saturday, and Easter Sunday.



Pope Emeritus Benedict once reminded us that as “we enter the Easter Triduum, the summit of the liturgical year” that celebrates “the central mystery of faith: the passion, death, and resurrection of Christ”, we should “allow ourselves to be touched by (his) love, to be transformed, so that the resurrection may really be realized in us.”

Do you know the opportunities that your parish offers during the Triduum? If not, be sure to check your bulletin. On Thursday, you might want to attend the Mass of The Lord’s Supper, when we remember Christ’s great gift of the Eucharist and spend time after Mass in adoration, uniting ourselves to his moment of prayer with the Father in the garden. On Friday, there is the opportunity to recall the Lord’s Passion through both the Good Friday service and also the Stations of the Cross. Then on Saturday, the beautiful liturgy of the Easter Vigil, where the Easter Fire is blessed, Salvation History is recounted in our readings, new members are welcomed into our Church, and we ourselves renew our baptismal promises with joy.

If you have never participated in the Triduum, perhaps this is the year to experience it for the first time, in whole or in part. You may be surprised at the ways participating in it may deepen and strengthen your faith.
